(Pre-K) To Infinity and Beyond: Join us for some spectacular fun. We will learn about planets, constellations, black holes, and NASA. Students will create papier mache planets, build with moonsand, make space slime, build an alien, and create our own planetarium in the classroom. (Pre-K-1) Invitation Only- Blast Off! Blast into space with us to learn about the universe. We'll make alien art, play galactic games, and take a virtual field trip to NASA. Join us for an out of this world experience! **Ms. Gordo**

We will conduct experiments, learn how the night sky works, and integrate basic academic skills in this fun filled week of learning. (1st-2nd) Spring into Summer: Each day, we'll cover one STEAM area, along with literacy-based learning. We'll read a different seasonal book each day for in-depth study, centers, and games. Let's learn all the changes involved as the Earth revolves from season to season. **Ms. Neubert**

(3rd-5th) Appalachian Adventure: We will travel the Appalachian Trail to learn about the music and culture of those who settled in the Appalachian Mountains. We'll play their music on recorders, ukuleles, xylophones, and even dulcimers! We will end our trek on Friday by playing folk songs around a (mock) campfire and eating s'mores! **Ms. Hayslip**

(3rd-5th) Shreve Island Escape Room: Escape Shreve Island! Put on your detective hats and sharpen your investigation skills!
